STATE CRECHE

West Bengal Social Welfare Board

With the support of West Bengal Social Welfare Board, Raghunathpur Nari Kalyan Samity runs a creche for the poor and marginalised children, in Ramratanpur of Kakdwip. At present 25 children regularly receives educational and nutritional support under this programme.

MOTHER & CHILD CARE | WOMEN EMPOWERMENT

Self Funding

Raghunathpur Nari Kalyan Samity organises different programmes and activities focusing on health of mother and child and women empowerment. Among the activities are awareness meetings on health, hygiene, sanitation, immunisation of children, income generation through SHGs. These programmes are run in different villages of Kakdwip block.

SAFE DRINKING WATER IN SCHOOL

Bharat Petroleum Corporation Limited

Raghunathpur Nari Kalyan Samity with the financial assistance of BPCL installed four tube well for safe drinking water in four schools of Kulpi and Magrahat I block. Around 3,360 students benefitted from these tube wells. The students now have access to safe drinking water in their school premises.

The four schools where these tube wells were installed are:

1. Mirzapur Ganesh Chandra High School | 2. Ailpara Free Primary School | 3. Hatugang Girls High School
4. Karanjali B. K. Institution



INDIVIDUAL HOUSEHOLD LATRINES

ONGC

In an effort to make the district open defecation free, Raghunathpur Nari Kalyan Samity, with the financial aid of Oil and Natural Gas Commission (ONGC), constructed household latrines for individual households in Halderchak village of Kakdwip block.

55 such latrines were constructed benefitting more than 275 people across the village.



FORMATION OF SELF HELP GROUP

Self Funding

Raghunathpur Nari Kalyan Samity (RNKS) facilitates the formation of Self Help Groups in order to empower them to save money and loan it among the members to begin income generation activities. RNKS also offers different capacity building programmes for these SHG including SHG management, book keeping, skill enhancement training etc. 62 such SHGs have been formed and is functioning in Kakdwip block of South 24 Parganas.

RNKS RURAL LIBRARY

District Rural Library

Raghunathpur Nari Kalyan Samity (RNKS) runs a rural library for local students and community members. This library not only provide free books on loan to students but also to book lovers in the village. This library is operational in Anandanagar village of Kakdwip block with the support of District Rural Library.
